



<b>Policy Title:</b>	<b>Appeal of contest result policy</b>
<b>Created/Revised:</b>	December 2014
<b>Approved:</b>	
<b>Summary:</b>	The policy outlines how the Combat Sports Authority will handle requests for appeals of contest results.
<b>Policy Statement:</b>	The policy details when an appeal will be considered by the CSA. Generally the CSA will not over-ride decisions made by judges or referees at a contest, unless there is evidence of bias or corruption.
<b>Applicability:</b>	Combatant's or their representative seeking to appeal a contest result.
<b>Procedure:</b>	<p>Any requests for an appeal of a contest decision must be made in writing to the CSA, clearly outlining the reason for the request. The request must include the details of any alleged bias or corruption and any evidence should be attached/provided.</p> <p>The CSA will only consider over-riding a contest result if there is substantiated evidence of bias or corruption.</p>
<b>Check types:</b>	Requests will be considered on their merit. Footage of the contest and other information may be requested by the CSA.
