Program Officer

This role delivers active outdoor recreation activities for a variety of schools, holiday camps, underrepresented groups, or corporate and sporting groups.

Requirements:

- Degree Level Tertiary Qualifications in relevant field or
- Certificate IV in Outdoor Recreation and relevant industry experience
- First Aid Certificate
- Current Working with Children Check (WWCC) Clearance
- On-call responsibilities (rostered basis during residential programs)
- Current Drivers Licence

Group Leader

This role is suitable for a range of people that enjoy working with others. You may come from a sport coaching background, childcare, the fitness and recreation or the outdoors industry.

Requirements:

- First Aid Certificate (or willingness to obtain)
- Current Working with Children Check (WWCC) Clearance
- Undertake on-call responsibilities on a rostered basis during residential programs
- Current Drivers Licence



Catering Officer

In this role you are responsible for the preparation and cooking of all meals for the visitors participating in the Centre's various programs.

Requirements:

- Current Hygiene and Food Safety Certificates
- First Aid Certificate (or willingness to obtain)
- Current Working with Children Check (WWCC) Clearance
- Willingness to work on a rostered basis

Services Officer

In this role you will complete maintenance work relating to the Centre grounds, buildings, equipment, and vehicles, to ensure the safety, and well-being of clients.

- Current Working with Children Check (WWCC) Clearance
- Current Drivers Licence
