

Registering Your AED on the NSW Ambulance AED Registry

To support community safety and improve public access to life-saving equipment, all successful applicants of the Local Sport Defibrillator Grant Program 2025/26 must register their AED on the NSW Ambulance AED Registry. NSW Ambulance maintains the NSW AED Registry, with AED locations provided by owners.

Why is this required?

Registering your AED helps emergency services and the public quickly locate nearby defibrillators during a cardiac emergency. This requirement aligns with NSW Government efforts to enhance emergency response capabilities.

Funding Condition

As part of your funding agreement, you must:

- Register your AED on the NSW Ambulance AED Registry via GoodSAM.
- Provide evidence of registration (confirmation email) in your Project Completion and Financial Acquittal Report.

How to Register Your AED

1. Go to the NSW Ambulance AED Registry at GoodSAM:

2. Complete the form, including:
 - AED information
 - A photo of the AED from a few steps back
 - Availability information
 - Location information
 - Your contact details
3. Submit your AED registration.
4. Save the confirmation email from GoodSAM. You'll need this for your acquittal report.
