Notification of Works – Carss Park Pool Project

The NSW Government, in partnership with Georges River Council, has engaged ADCO Constructions to undertake the construction of the new Carss Park Pool.

This project will deliver:

- A modern outdoor eight-lane, 50-metre swimming pool with a swim wall and associated infrastructure.
- A 20-metre by 10-metre Learn to Swim pool with an accessible ramp.
- Contemporary change room facilities and supporting amenities.

The facility will be constructed to contemporary industry standards, providing a safe, accessible and fit-for-purpose environment that supports community swimming and aquatic recreation.

Construction is scheduled to commence in early August 2026 and is anticipated to be completed in late 2027. Works may be undertaken Monday to Saturday between 7.00am and 6.00pm.

All works will be carried out in accordance with the requirements of the Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997 and relevant NSW Environment Protection Authority requirements to minimise impacts on nearby residents, park users and the surrounding environment.

During construction, the Carss Park Flats Car Park, adjacent to the former pool site, will be closed to the public. Alternative parking will be available within the Carss Park Hill Car Park (Figure 1) and a temporary car park on Carlton Crescent (Figure 2).

Where practicable, all other services and facilities within Carss Park will remain open and operational throughout the construction period.

The Carss Park Pool Project represents a significant investment in community infrastructure by the Australian Government, NSW Government and Georges River Council. Council remains committed to delivering a modern aquatic facility for the community and is proud to be working with its government partners to bring this important project to fruition.
