

Policy Title:	Insurance Requirements
Created/Revised: Approved:	December 2014
Summary:	The policy outlines the CSA's requirements in relation to insurances required to be held by persons and organisations operating in the combat sports industry.
Policy Statement:	The policy details when insurances must be held and the required level of coverage, where applicable.
Background:	Organisations and persons working in the combat sports industry are responsible for managing risks associated with their activities, including obtaining insurance coverage.
Applicability:	Covers all persons registering with the CSA and all Approved Amateur Bodies.
Procedure:	Where insurance is mandatory, the certificate of currency will be checked by staff. Where the Insurance is held in the name other than the Promoter, AAB or venue, the promoter will be contacted and advised to ensure that the Public Liability covers the event.
